Throughout the exhibition 'The Democratic Dish: Mintons Secessionist Ware' visitors are invited to complete this template (physical or digital - www.chelseaspace.org/archive/mintons-transfer.html) inspired by the work on display. From the submissions, four will be selected to be turned into transfers and workshopped onto large ceramic plates (chargers).

Submissions close on Friday 19 October, with the judges' selection announced on Friday October 26, the final day of the exhibition. The workshop for the winning designers will be led by **Amy Hughes**, ceramic artist and specialist ceramics technician at Chelsea College of Arts, on Saturday 3 November.

The ceramics will then be on display for six weeks in the Chelsea Cafe opposite Chelsea Space (19 Nov - 14 Jan).

Judges include: **Grayson Perry** RA, Turner Prize Winner and UAL Chancellor; **Donald Smith**, Director of Chelsea Space; and ceramic artist **Amy Hughes**.
